



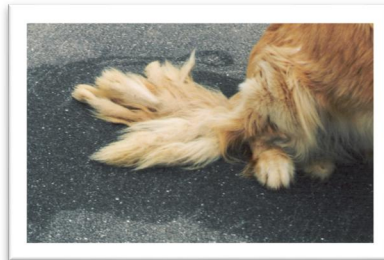

Finn came into Delaware Valley Golden Retriever Rescue's program in the spring of 2004 at 3 years of age. He weighed 40 pounds, had whip worm, Lyme positive, black teeth, and dread locks hanging off his tail. Judie, Finn's adoptive owner first came in contact with Finn when she evaluated him at her local Humane Society. He wrapped himself around her heart that day and will remain there forever.



Being severely underweight, he quickly started to thrive on a good diet and dedicated training.

Finn had a zest for life and was a happy boy who “Did it all”. He competed in Traditional Obedience, Rally, Agility and his personal favorite, Dock Diving. He loved being in the water and would stay there all day if Judie would let him. He also loved travelling with Judie to these events and did his thing at three Golden Retriever National Specialties; Gettysburg, PA (2005), Providence, RI (2008) and Conyers, GA (2011). He always represented the Rescue well when he would “Strut his stuff” in the Parade of Champions as well as in the Rescue Parade. He also attended the Dock Diving Nationals in Ohio.

On his off days, he loved hanging around the house with his brothers Doc, a Golden and little Tucker, a Miniature Schnauzer. Finn will go down in the history books as one of the greatest dogs ever and certainly one of the most accomplished rescue dogs.
